Binegar Cemetery – fees

Applicable from 1 April 2014

There are two levels of fees:

1 Parishioner

- A person who, before his or her death, was a parishioner of the civil parish of Binegar in the County of Somerset
- A still-born child where the parents (or one parent) were, or at the time of the interment are, parishioners
- At the discretion of the Council, a person who had a close relationship with the parish before his or her death

2 Non-parishioner

- A person from outside the parish of Binegar but who wishes to be interred in Binegar Cemetery.

Fees

Standard size grave plot Purchase of 50 year <i>Exclusive Right of Burial</i>	Parishioner	Non-parishioner
1. A child (less than 12 months or stillborn) plot 4ft by 2ft by 4ft deep	Free	£75
2. Children not exceeding 15 years of age	£100	£200
3. A single depth grave plot	£175	£350
4. A double depth grave plot	£175	£350
5. Cremated remains plot	£50	£100
6. Further 50 years <i>Exclusive Right of Burial</i> after initial 50 years	50% prevailing fee	50% prevailing fee

A specific fee will be calculated and quoted for a plot size greater than standard.

Purchase of an *Exclusive Right of Burial* will normally only be made at the same time as an interment. Reservations may be permitted on request but, if approved by Binegar Parish Council, this will include a reservation fee of £50 in addition to the fee for the *Exclusive Right of Burial*.

Interment	Parishioner	Non-parishioner
1. Stillborn child or of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 months	£100	£100
2. All others	£100	£100
3. Of the body of a person whose age at time of death exceeded 12 years	£100	£100
4. Interment of ashes in a grave plot or cremated remains plot	£100	£100

Memorials and inscriptions thereon	Parishioner	Non-parishioner
1. Permission to erect a headstone, wooden cross, book, tablet, scroll or similar	£90	£180
2. Cremation tablet	£60	£120
3. Further inscription (after the first)	£30	£60
